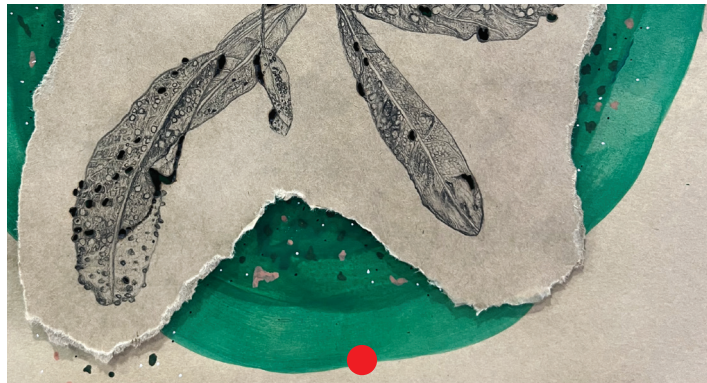
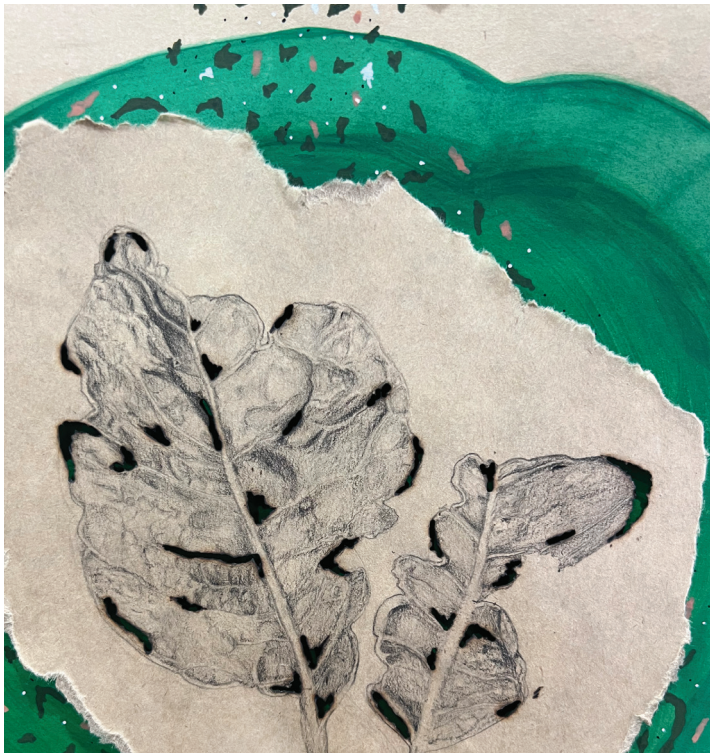

## OUR COLLEGE LOGO



The name “Pacific” reminds us of our proximity to the ocean. “Pacific” can also remind us of calmness. Magellan gave the ocean its name when relieved to find calmer water after experiencing the treacherous seas around Cape Horn at the tip of South America.

At Pacific Lutheran College, we are reminded of the peace that Christians experience through their faith in their Creator and Saviour God.

In our logo, the significant cross reminds us of Jesus, the Son of God, and the One whom Christians worship as the Light of the World. The sextant, an important navigational instrument, placed behind the cross reminds us of the new directions lives can take through faith in Jesus Christ. The cross and sextant together form the outline of a boat with sails on a calm and peaceful sea.

Life is a journey of discovery and Christians look to Christ as their Captain and Navigator. At Pacific Lutheran College, we celebrate the peacefulness of our surroundings, the beauty of sand and blue skies (also depicted in our logo) and calmness that comes through our Christian faith.
