

2026 Music Scholarship Application Form

Eligibility

To apply for a Pacific Lutheran College Music Scholarship, the applicant must have a minimum standard of AMEB Grade 3 or equivalent in their chosen instrument. It would be desired if the applicant had music theory knowledge.

Audition Process

- Candidates will be invited to attend an interview/audition with the Head of Music and the Head of Instrumental Music.
- Candidates should prepare 2 contrasting performance pieces on their main instrument/voice at an AMEB Grade 3 (or equivalent) standard or higher.
- Where a candidate has indicated that they play more than one instrument, they will be required to show their ability on both instruments
- The audition will also include sight reading at a relevant level, aural/singing tests and a 30-minute musicianship/theory written test paper
- Piano accompaniment is not required but if it is preferred then will need to be provided by the candidate.
