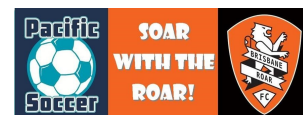


Pacific Soccer

Our U11A Pacific Taipans welcomed back Jonti and Macey from the Queensland State Titles and faced the Chancellor Chargers last weekend. However at the other end, good teamwork from the Taipans gave them several goals in the second half. The Taipans took a comfortable 6:1 win and the points for this round.

Our U11B Pacific Cobras played the Immanuel Sharks, which saw another closely fought game between two evenly matched teams. In an exciting game, it was Immanuel who was finally able to take the points for this round, with a 3:2 win.

Our U12B Pacific Sharks played Caloundra White and again were strong in attack, with several good scoring chances. Caloundra also had their chances at the other end of the field. In a close match that could have gone either way, it was Caloundra who was able to get to the front, to secure a 2:1 result.



The final game at Pacific was played between our U13B Pacific Snappers and the Immanuel Jets. The first half was closely fought, with little separating the teams. Immanuel scored some quick goals; to take a commanding 3:0 lead into the half-time break. Despite the imposing scoreline, the Snappers showed great team effort in the second half and managed to score soon after the break. The Snappers defence was solid in the second half and prevented Immanuel scoring again. Their attack threatened at the other end, finally giving them a second goal. Sadly time was not on their side, because the Snappers were not able to find a third goal to draw the game. Immanuel took the points for this round, with a 3:2 win.
