Semi-Finals and Rooball Carnival

With the completion of the regular rounds, the final games for our U6-U10 teams were played last weekend at a Rooball Carnival. Pacific Soccer provided three fields for U8 carnival games, which allowed our Barracudas, Vipers, and Jewelfish to play at home. The Rooball Carnival also coincided with semi-final games, four of which were played at Pacific, including the U11A Pacific Taipans match. Our U13B Pacific Snappers played their semi-final game away at Palmwoods.

At Pacific, in a play-off between first and second place on the table, our U11A Pacific Taipans faced the Bli Bli Dragons, with the victor earning the right to progress straight to the grand final. Like other games throughout the season, there was very little between the top-ranked teams, with chances for both sides and the defensive lines being continually challenged. At the final whistle, the Taipans claimed victory with a narrow 2:1 result! The Bli Bli Dragons will be playing the Buddina Stingrays in the preliminary finals this weekend, so the Taipans will be facing one of these teams again in the grand final on 3rd September.



The U13B Pacific Snappers' game against the Palmwoods Raiders was also a play-off between first and second place on the table. The Palmwoods Raiders were an A Grade side in 2015, but were moved to the B Grade this year. Although the Raiders have dominated in this division throughout the season, some games have been extremely close. Last weekend the Snappers were impressive in the first half and went to the break trailing only 0:1. It looked as if an upset against the Raiders was a possibility. But despite a great effort from the Snappers, the Raiders maintained pressure in the second half and scored a few late goals to secure their place in the grand final. The Pacific Snappers will be playing the Immanuel Jets in the preliminary finals at Palmwoods this weekend. The game kicks off at 11.20am, so if you have some spare time, come along on Saturday morning and show your support for the Snappers. The victor will progress to the grand final on 3rd September.
