Start of 2017 Season

The wait is over! The 2017 season is kicking off this weekend with around 150 Pacific Soccer players across 13 teams taking to the field. Please ensure players are ready for the first games and have all their equipment (shin guards, boots, full uniforms, hair ties). SCCSA rules don't allow children to play without the required gear.

Nearly all of our teams are full, but we are still looking for one x U6 boy or girl player (born 2011 or 2012).

Rooball Carnival – U6-U10 Teams

Our U6-U10 teams will play in a Rooball Carnival this weekend, with each team playing two to three shortened games. Pacific Soccer will be hosting some U08 games, so our U8 Seadragons and U8 Vipers are playing at home.

Our other Rooball teams will be playing at Bli Bli (U6 Starfish, U9 Jewelfish), Caloundra (U7 Razors, U7 Marlins), Siena Catholic College (U6 Sea Eagles, U10 Seals), Currimundi (U7 Mantarays) and Palmwoods (U9 Barracudas).

A few quick reminders regarding the Rooball Carnival:

- There is a \$5 fee per player for the carnival, which will be collected by the manager of each team.
- Players will receive a ribbon at the end of their last game.
- Managers, please note that only one team sheet needs to be filled in for the day, which must include your team and player details.
- For those teams playing at Pacific, we are seeking canteen volunteers. Please contact your manager if you're able to help.



Grading Games – U11+ Teams

Our U11+ competitive teams will play their first of three grading games this weekend. Pacific Soccer is also hosting some grading games, so our U11 Eels, U12 Cobras and U14 Snappers will play at home. The first games at Pacific commence at 8.30am and the last U8 Rooball game kicks off at 3.00pm. Everyone is welcome to come along and enjoy the exciting action on the field.

Coaches and Managers

A few teams are still in need of a coach or a manager. These positions can be shared within the families of each team, to suit availability. If you would like to help your team, coaching or managing is a great way to become actively involved and your participation is always appreciated by the club, but more importantly by the players.

Pacific Soccer's partnership with Brisbane Roar will provide ongoing support for our team coaches throughout the 2017 season. Roar coaches will visit on a weekly basis to share suggestions and training options where needed.

SCCSA is also holding free coaching clinics in March that are specifically designed for U6-U8 and U9-U16 age groups. The clinics run from 6.00pm to 8.30pm on the following dates:

- U6-U8: Thursday 2nd March at Frank McIvor Park, Currimundi
- U9-U16: Thursday 9th March at Multisports Complex, Mudjimba
- U6-U16: Tuesday 14th March at Multisports Complex, Mudjimba

The clinics provide guidance on training methods, individual and group management, specific skills training for particular age groups, goal keeping, shooting and basic defensive / attacking principles. Team Training

With the announcement of the team lists, weekly training is now underway for most teams. The coach and manager choose the specific training day for each team. Please remember shin pads must be worn for training and matches.

The fields at Pacific are always busy at the start of the season. Pacific Lutheran College has established a good relationship with the Meridan Sports Complex, which has allowed their fields to be used by PLC teams, when additional space is required. We ask our teams to also respect this relationship. Remember that training is never permitted on fields #1 and #2.

Wet Weather Cancellations

Throughout the season, in the event that games have to be cancelled due to wet weather, team managers will be advised via SMS and this information will then be relayed to each family. Notifications will also be sent via the Team App.

Reminders – Training and Games

Please remember that dogs and smoking are not permitted at any games or at training. These rules are intended to protect our players, officials and spectators and apply not only at the Pacific fields, but any other venue our teams play at.

Canteen Renovations

Since the end of the 2016 season, we have been undertaking a refurbishment of the canteen area. We have just finished lining and painting the internal walls and are gradually installing storage cupboards and shelves, to simplify the organisation of the canteen area.

We would especially like to thank Shane Gale (Shadforths) and Matt Power (MJP), who have installed running water into the canteen and a submersible pump as well as connected a drainage line from the sink. Having running water in the canteen is a huge benefit for our volunteers. We would also like to thank Chris Friend, Zane Russell (Suncoast Building Approvals) and Mr Mike Healy, for assisting with the organisation and the approval processes that allowed this work to be completed.



Pacific Soccer Canteen

The operation of the canteen is a vital role within Pacific Soccer. The revenue from the canteen is the principle source of income for the club and allows us to purchase equipment for our teams throughout each season. At this stage, the logistic effort to supply and coordinate the operation of the canteen is being overseen by the existing committee members. However, we are still hoping to get some extra help from a Canteen Organiser and a Canteen Manager.

During each home game, volunteers from our teams run the canteen, overseen by the Canteen Manager. With eight home games in the 2017 season and 13 teams, we are intending to roster two teams in the canteen for each home game for either the morning shift (7.00am – 12.00pm) or the afternoon shift (12.00pm – 5.00pm). Teams will be asked to help with a shift only once or twice during the 2017 season.

A minimum of three volunteers are required in the canteen at any time. With our team numbers varying from eight to 15 players, if each family can provide a volunteer for their team's rostered day, people would be helping for no longer than 1.5 – 2 hours. We ask all our families to provide assistance when asked by your team manager.

Working Bee – 25th February

Our annual working bee was held last Saturday and we thank everyone who came along to help with various tasks, including:

- Spring cleaning the canteen area;
- Completing the drainage work at the end of the concrete path;
- Organising team equipment and canteen equipment;
- Attaching an awning over the canteen window; and
- Installing internal lining and painting the canteen walls.
