Round 5 Games

Please check the website or Team App to see the match details for this week (Round 5). Round 5 consists of home games for all Pacific teams. Thank you to the U7 Razors and U7 Mantarays, who have been rostered on for canteen duty this weekend and will be providing volunteers to assist throughout the day. Our other teams will be rostered for our remaining home games throughout the season and will generally be asked to assist with shifts of up to two hours, from 7.30am until 5.00pm.

Wet Weather Cancellations

With Cyclone Debbie causing havoc in North Queensland, we will most likely have some weather issues later in the week. However, just because it is raining does not necessarily mean that games will be cancelled. All games will always be going ahead unless advised otherwise, so please keep in contact with our Facebook pages (PLC or SCCSA) and the Team App.

We will make it clear to all Pacific families if games are cancelled. In the event that games have to be cancelled due to wet weather, team managers will be advised via SMS and this information can then be relayed to each family. Notifications will also be sent via the Team App and Facebook.

Training and Games – Reminders

As we are having home games this week, please remember that dogs and smoking are not permitted at games or at training. These rules are intended to protect our players, officials and spectators and not only apply at Pacific's fields, but also at all other grounds where our teams play.

Playing Attire – Hats

In the grades U8 and below, soft bucket style hats can be worn on field but no peaked caps are allowed. Please ensure we abide by these rules for the safety of all players.
