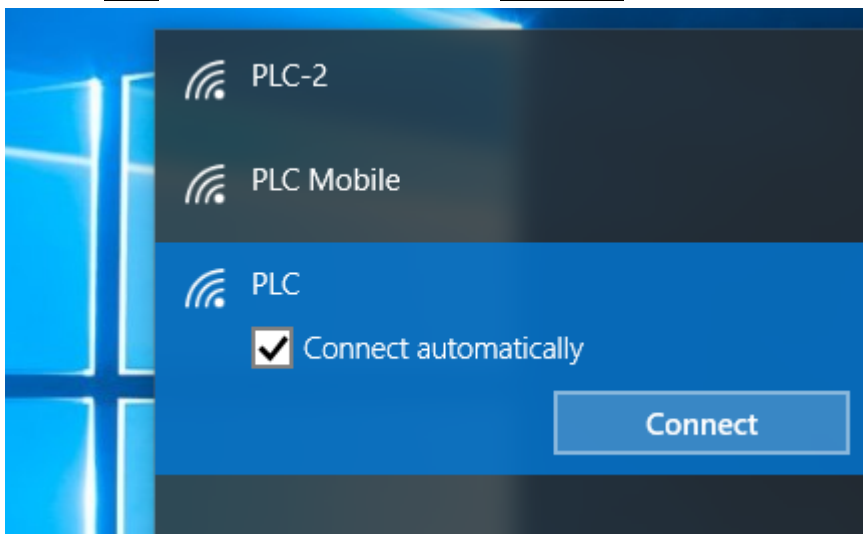


## Connecting to Wireless on Windows 10
