#### **Amati**

Please feel free to send any string student along who is able to play well and read in D Major. Amati will be working on Adamant and Dragonhunter both pieces would be something we would start with at the beginning of the year and would expect that it would be well learnt quickly. This group starts the year at .5 but by this stage they have reached level 1.5/2.

#### **Sinfonia**

Sinfonia students will be practising for their upcoming Gala performance and Brisbane Musicfest but if you have a higher-level student wanting to come and try they are more than welcome to attend. They will be workshopping Pieces of Eight by Richard Meyer - at the lower level of the pieces they usually play and Dramatic Essay. This group usually plays pieces 2.5 and above

### **Brass, Winds and Percussion Concert Band 11.00am – 12.30pm**

Brass, woodwind and percussion players should be progressing through their first tutor book and nearly at the end of the book, with students reading notes and finding fingerings independently.

Trumpet, trombone, euphonium and tuba players should be able to play their Concert Bb major scale.

French Horn players should be able to play their C major scale. Woodwind players should be able to play in Bb major, with a developing knowledge of Eb and F major. Percussion students should be prepared to play both tuned and untuned percussion parts, even if they are unfamiliar with tuned percussion.

The Concert Band started the year playing Level 1 repertoire and is now working on majority Level 2 repertoire. The workshop day repertoire will be Level 0.5-1.5.
